

**VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES**  
**ADJOURNED MEETING OF MAY 16, 2016**  
**MAY 31, 2016** **7 PM**

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Mayor Neville reconvened the meeting of May 16<sup>th</sup> at 7 pm.

Present were: Mayor Neville, Trustees Evener, Conger, Morey and Holl, Chet Symanski-CT Male Assoc.

Mr. Symanski reviewed the answers he had created for Parts II and III and that "There will be no moderate or large negative impact due to this project".

We received no opinion for the Village taking lead agency from the Office of Community Renewal, Department of Transportation and the Army Corp of Engineers (even though they are concerned on Williams Street about maintaining the natural channel).

Trustee Evener offered the following resolution:

Following solicitation for coordinated review with all involved agencies, and review of all pertinent information submitted to the Village of Groton pursuant to the State Environmental Quality Review Act, the Village of Groton hereby resolves that the proposed project entitled the Groton Stormwater Improvements Project, CDBG #487PR49-15 is an unlisted action under the SEQRA. It is further Resolved that the proposed action will not result in any significant adverse environmental impacts and an Environmental Impact Statement is not required.

Seconded by Trustee Holl, carried.

Mr. Symanski noted that the West South Street portion will require a DEC stormwater permit. Williams Street will require the DEC stormwater permit and Army Corp of Engineers approval.

There was discussion concerning a sewer problem at 303 East Cortland Street. Code Enforcement will further investigate this.

The meeting was closed at 7:30 pm.
