The Village of Groton has several boards that provide the opportunity for **you** to participate in **your Village's** future. The citizens working on these boards participate in making decisions to give the Village Board of Trustees advice. We currently have vacancies on the following boards:

<u>Zoning Board of Appeals</u> – the zoning board of appeals is empowered to hear and decide appeals from any person aggrieved by an administrative decision. The role of the ZBA is to determine whether the decision was authorized or supported by the zoning ordinance.

<u>Groton Housing Authority</u> – is a quasi-agency of the Village, which has oversight of the Center Village Court Senior Citizens complex at 200 West South St. Members of the authority have management oversight of the facility; working with the management company and act as a liaison with residents of the housing. Non-residents of the housing are preferred.

Minimum qualifications for above boards:

- a) Citizen of the United States.
- b) At least 18 years of age.
- c) Resident of the Village of Groton for at least 30 days.
